Did you know?

The monarch butterfly is sometimes called the "milkweed butterfly" because its larvae can only eat milkweed.

The toxins from the monarch's milkweed diet have given

the butterfly this defense. In either the caterpillar or butterfly stage the monarch needs no camouflage because it takes in toxins from the milkweed and is poisonous to predators.
